I received the following information from Terrence Ates. Please share this wonderful opportunity with parents in your district.

The attached documents relate to a free event that has been held at Van Middle School since 2013. Any person, regardless of residence, who does not have medical insurance nor dental insurance can attend the annual East Texas Medical and Dental Outreach and receive FREE basic medical services and FREE dental screenings.

The dates are Tuesday, June 28th and Wednesday, June 29th, from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. both days. Early arrival is encouraged, mainly because most of the available health services are free and will be provided on a first-come, first-serve basis (especially the free dental screenings).

This is a very worthwhile opportunity for school districts to promote on their webpages and through their parental e-communications, as well as for employees and staff of school districts who may not have the necessary medical/dental insurance.

The free services include adult & child wellness exams, student athlete physicals, mammograms, asthma & vision screenings & registration for social assistance benefits (CHIP, TANF, Medicaid/Medicare, SSI, etc.).
