Needs and Academic Outcomes	
The ACE program at West Rusk Intermediate is based on the 2016-17 TAPR and is designed to impact student performance and promotion at all grades and in all subjects that are below the state average. The hours of operation include hours before and after school that accommodate working families, and the entire program will help students transcend their current socio-economics limitations. ACE goals and objectives mirror the District Campus Plans.	
Each student should meet or exceed Meets Grade Level performance on the STAAR ELAR assessment.	Of the students attending 45 days or more with an average attendance of 2 hours or more per day, thirty-one out of 67 students or 46% in the 4th and 5th grades taking the STAAR ELAR assessments scored either Meets or Masters level. This includes 31 or 77% of the students who moved up at least one level.
Each student should meet or exceed Meets Grade Level performance on the STAAR Math assessment.	Of the students attending 45 days or more with an average attendance of 2 hours or more per day, 22 out of 67 students or 33% in the 4th and 5th grades taking the STAAR ELAR assessments scored either the Meets or Masters level. This includes 7 of the students who moved up at least one level.
